What is it?

What do I need to know?

- The NWEA is an adaptive assessment called a MAP test that will provide your child's teacher with detailed information to aide in individualized instruction.
- The MAP test is administered to students in grades K-5 on computers.
- The MAP test adapts based on how the student answers each question.
- Teachers get quick feedback on student progress.
- The test will be given 3 times per year and will assess both Reading and Mathematics skills.
- NOT ANOTHER TEST!? Don't worry! We are not just adding another test. The MAP test is replacing the District Benchmark tests that were given 3 times per year.
